The Premier of South Australia has announced restrictions to help prevent the spread of the Delta strain of COVID-19 should it make its way into South Australia.

While these current restrictions don't directly impact daily preschool or school operations, it's a reminder that we must continue to be prepared and responsive to the changing nature of the pandemic.

QR check in

Please continue to use the COVID-safe check-in when you enter our site. This information is vital to ensure SA Health contact tracers can notify you if you have been in close contact with someone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19.

Our site's QR code is clearly displayed at all entrances to buildings. Hard copy sign-in is also available at the Front Office.

We again ask that all parents and visitors scan in each time you enter the school, including when dropping off or collecting children. For those parents who do not use a smartphone or do not have the app, paper sign-in sheets are available at the Front Office.

Parents and caregivers are asked to drop students at the classroom door and not enter classrooms.

Pre-school families can enter the pre-school to sign their child in.

Masks

Wearing masks is not required in preschool, school or office settings, unless a student or staff member chooses to wear one.

Indoor seated performances such as school assemblies will still go ahead but parents (if in attendance) may choose to wear a mask.

Singing

Singing as part of an educational program can continue.

Vaccination

Getting vaccinated against COVID-19 is the next thing we can all do to protect ourselves and the greater community.

School Uniform Reminder

We have noticed that some students have been coming to school not wearing school uniform lately. Wearing of the Wandana School uniform is compulsory for all students in Reception through to Year 7. Black pants, jeans and hoodies (excluding the Year 6/7 senior jumper) are not permitted.

School uniform is important because:

- we know immediately if there are strangers on campus
- it encourages student pride in themselves and their school
- it enhances our public image and identity
- reduces peer pressure
- provides families with a cost effective option for school clothing

All students must wear:

- Navy blue t-shirt or polo shirt – either plain or with the Wandana School logo
- Navy blue jumper or jacket – either plain or with the Wandana School logo
- Plain navy blue shorts, skirts or skorts (knee length) or plain long navy blue pants
- Blue and white gingham summer dress
- Shoes: sneakers / joggers
- Hat: Wandana School legionnaire's hat (provided) – all year

Students who are not wearing school uniform will be given a uniform to wear by the Office. Students will need to change back into their original clothing at the end of the day.

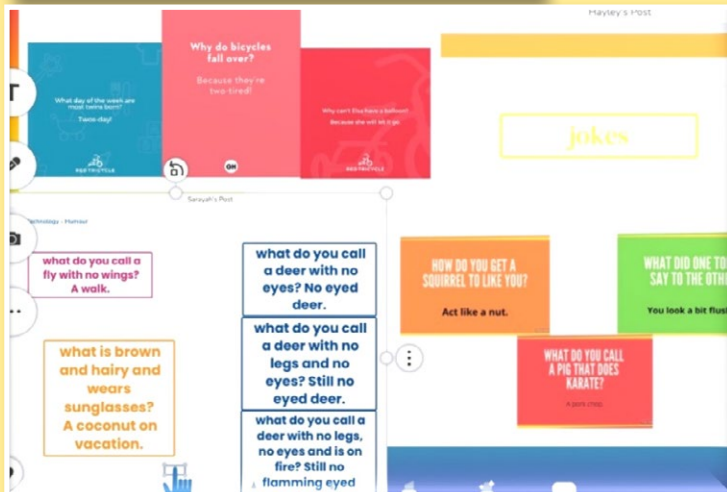
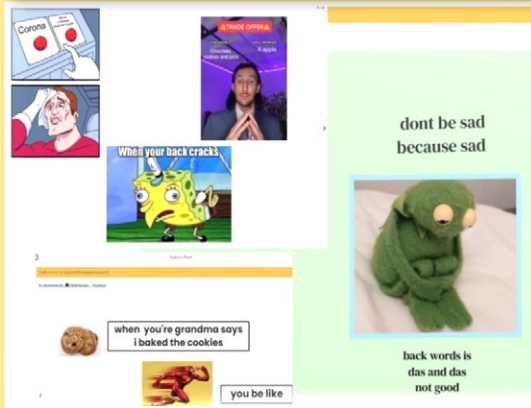
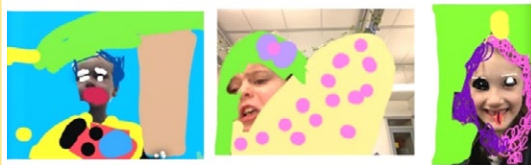
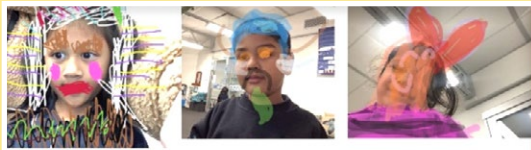


Humour and Technology

4. The last part was to create a meme.



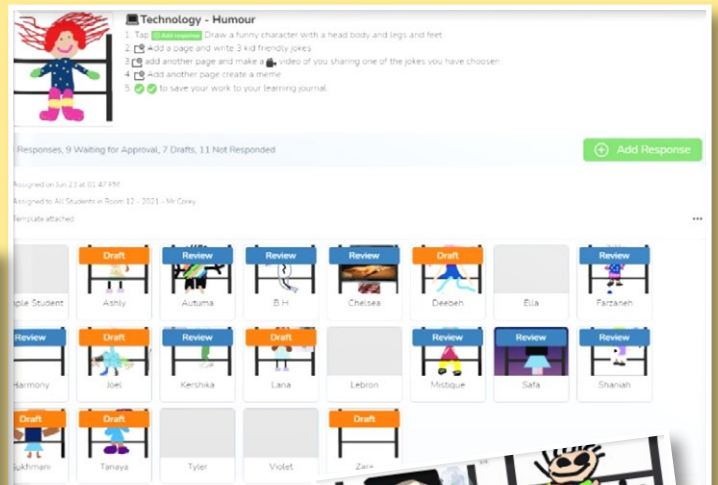
