Dear Parents and Caregivers,

PAT tests will provide teachers with objective information for setting realistic learning goals and planning effective programs. They will also provide students with information to inform their learning and goal setting, as well as providing our school with information to measure improvement during each year of schooling and over a number of years. If you have any further questions please ask your child's classroom teacher.

We look forward to building on their experience, ideas and questions from the excursion as the term progresses. A big THANK YOU to all the grown-ups who came to help keep us safe on the day!


























