Leadership Report

Festival of Music 2019: Wandana Choir Performance

This year over 600 staff and volunteers have been involved in delivering the Festival of Music program which provides high quality learning for over 11,000 government school students, performing to an annual audience of over 30,000.

There are Festival Choirs in over 300 schools across South Australia, in addition to three Orchestras and two Performance Troupes in metropolitan Adelaide. The Festival also showcases soloists and ensembles from public primary and secondary schools. The concert series provides many opportunities for our young public school students to experience a once-in-a-lifetime professional performance on a world-class stage.

Ms Laura and 11 students from Year 5-7 will embark on Festival Theatre Tuesday 17th of September to perform in their collaborated schools performance. Tickets are still available from Bass for \$40 if you wanted to go and support our fantastic choir. Good luck kids!

Progressive Achievement Tests (PAT)

Students in Years 2-7 have been participating in the National Progressive Achievement Tests and this will continue till the end of Week 9. Reading, Mathematics, Grammar and Punctuation and Spelling are the areas tested, however their intended purpose is very different to NAPLAN testing.

The main aim of PAT is to provide information to teachers on the strengths and needs of the students. PAT tests will provide teachers with objective information to help set realistic academic learning goals and areas for improvement planning. The tests indicate what skills students have mastered, what skills they are consolidating and even more importantly what skills they need to be stretched. Students will have their tests shown to them and growth points explained. The school keeps information and data to inform and measure improvements from year to year.

PAT is undertaken on a laptop or desktop computer and students are getting the opportunity to use and experience the platform. Students are very happy to talk to you about how they are going.

Positive Education: Social Intelligence

The character strength focus for the last two weeks has been on social intelligence. Students have been studying and gaining a deeper understanding of self and social awareness. Activities about belief statements, social and global current affairs and developing communication and relationship skills have contributed to building the capacity of our students.
