Book Week 2019 - Reading is my Secret Power

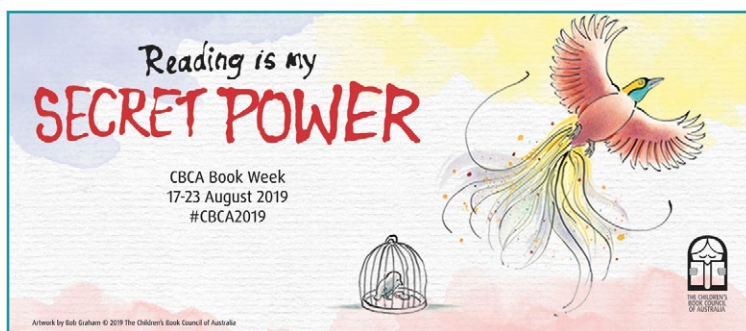
Children's Book Week in Australia is 17-23 August. The theme this year is 'Reading is my Secret Power.'

Children who will be 5 years old before 1 May 2020 can enrol in Reception.

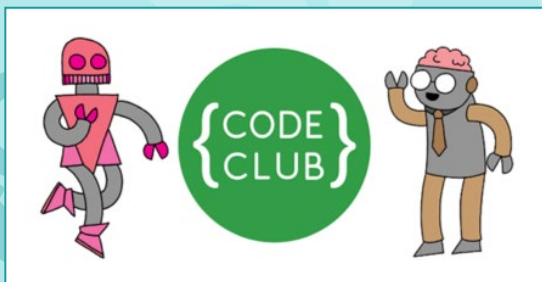

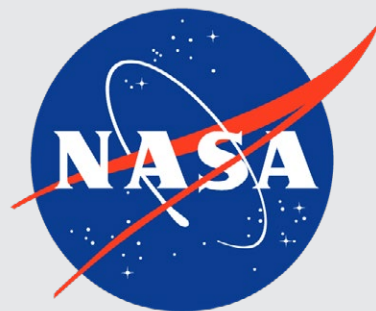
A note will be coming home to families soon with more information. You will also be able to count these hours to Children's University!

HASS

Pudna's Year 6 and 7 students have been learning all about values in HASS this term – personal values, school values and Australian values. Last week we discussed what the current character strength of prudence means and how it ties to values. The students made connections between how making careful 'prudent' choices about how they act and what they say leads to behaving in ways that upholds our school values of respect, learning and belonging. Then with Vicky's Reception/Year 1 buddy class, they explained their learning to their younger buddies and together started making a poster to visually represent their thinking. They traced their hands to make a tree top and then showed how prudence symbolises the ground in which the tree grows and the tree's foliage is made up of the school values. Pictured above is Anaya's and Leelah's work in progress. Leelah drew the tree and wrote the words and then Anaya got very creative with a brown texta!
